### **Elite sells 42 Basic Aircraft Training Devices to China**

Elite Simulation Solutions, a world leader in the design and manufacture of flight simulators powered by standard PCs, has sold 42 of its PI-135 BATD flight training devices to China.

The deal was brokered by Meridianaero, based in Beijing and Hong Kong who will install the FAA approved PI-135 BATDs at the Civil Aviation University of China in Tianjin. Meridianaero was set up in 2009 and serves the whole Chinese aviation market.

Specifically for this order Elite developed a Chinese GenView visual database along with an updated navigation database.

The Elite PI-135 allows students 2.5 hours towards a private licence rating and 10 hours towards an instrument rating. Built around the Elite Pro Panel II it can be used for complete start up, flight and shut down procedures and can be configured to match a number of Beech, Cessna, Mooney, Piper and Socata aircraft.
