LARGEST FTO IN GREECE BUYS ELITE SIMULATOR

Global Air Services, the largest flight training organisation in Greece, and one of the major ones throughout the South East Europe region, has bought an Elite S812 FPT II simulator to help train pilots on its all-Piper fleet.

The single pilot version of Elite's S812 is configured to represent the Piper Seneca III twin piston engine aircraft and features 3-channel visuals incorporating GenView Europe South East scenery that covers Greece and neighbouring countries.

Factory acceptance of the device has been completed and the new S812 is schedule for installation at Global's operational centre in Athens in November.

Global Air Services was set up in 1998, the year after its parent group Global Aviation was formed to offer sales of Piper and Bombardier aircraft, aircraft rental, aerial work and aircraft maintenance. The academy offers the PPL(A), CPL(A), ATPL(A) and FI(A) courses.

Global Air Services was looking for the right simulator for over a year before ordering Elite's S812.
