ELITE INSTALLS ITS FIRST SIMULATOR IN THE NETHERLANDS

The first Elite FNPT II MCC flight training device to be installed in The Netherlands is now being used to train pilots, having been certified by the Dutch CAA.

It is also the first sale in The Netherlands for Elite Simulation Solutions, the Swiss designer and manufacturer of flight training devices.

The Elite S923 system has been bought by Simulator Training Rotterdam (STR). It is available for pilot training and proficiency checks by STR's instructors, who will do all MCC courses offered on the device. It will also be offered to other FTOs to use with their own instructors.

Working to STR's requirements, Elite configured the S923 to represent the Beech King Air B200 twin, but it is easily and quickly convertible to represent the Piper Seneca III twin or the single engine Piper Arrow IV. It has a 3-channel external visual system and for use as a King Air it has EFIS instrumentation.

Nicole Groot - van den Hooff, Chief Operating Officer of STR, said: "We are proud to have the first Elite FNPT II MCC in the Netherlands, in fact the only SEP FNPT II in our country. The authorities were impressed by Swiss standards, which made the certification go very smoothly. The first customers are very enthusiastic and impressed by the device."
